Tammie Lane is an artist living in Aspen, Colorado since 1981. She has a BFA in Commercial Art from Phillips University, Enid, Oklahoma. She transferred from Oklahoma State University and also studied as an exchange student in Sweden. She has made her living painting oils and watercolors, doing a very wide range of illustrative work, and creating pottery for 37 years. Starting her career as an artist, Lane worked at Hallmark Cards, Inc. in Kansas City, MO. After a few years, she moved to Aspen, CO and opened Lane Illustration and Design. Lane worked with many national clients over the years producing work for children's books, magazines, posters, product design and misc. advertising. During that time, she was also showing her fine art in many galleries around the country. In 2008, she opened her own gallery, Lane Fine Art, in Aspen, Colorado. Her pottery and paintings have been exhibited in numerous one woman shows, juried shows and galleries throughout the United States.

The E.S. Lawrence Gallery in Taos and Aspen was her main gallery for 24 years. Other galleries she has shown with include The Jill Vickers Gallery in Las Vegas, Vail, and Aspen.
